


Figure 1: *Note:* The layout for both network plots was generated by the OpenOrd algorithm implement in the igraph package (Csardi and Nepusz 2006). Students are represented by circles where the colors identify their fields: deep red = multidisciplinary/mixed; orange = STEM; light red = humanities, arts, and design; deep blue = social sciences; medium blue = undeclared; light blue = business and law. White squares represent courses. The plots show only the largest component in each of the years.
